2020 Authorization of an Agent to Sell Chametz

I _____ hereby authorize Rabbi Azaryah Cohen and/or Rabbi Eliezer Finkelman to sell my leavened food to a non-Jewish person of their choice. The sale should take place before the prohibition of owning *chametz* comes into effect on the eve of Pesah, late in the morning of the 14th of Nisan, which this year falls on April 8, 2020.

I further authorize Rabbi Cohen and/or Rabbi Finkelman to rent to the purchaser the closet or other space where the leavened foods are stored for a period of nine days. The transfer of ownership of the leavened food will occur along with the transfer of the closet or other storage space.

“My leavened foods” includes, but is not limited to, all edible products containing wheat, barley, rye, oats or spelt which has come in contact with water and allowed to ferment. Included in my property is, if appropriate, the property of my spouse, and of my dependent children.

The leavened food consists of:

It has an approximate value of \$_____. This represents a rough approximation. An expert appraiser, with the approval of the rabbis and the purchaser, will set the exact. Although the rabbis will receive only a partial payment towards this unstated total amount, the sale will be completed with this partial payment, and all responsibility for the leavened food transferred to the purchaser. The remainder of the payment will have the status of an independent debt owed by the purchaser to me.
